4-hour Hazardous Materials Awareness Level Course

Course Description: This four (4) hour awareness course will provide first responders the basic skills necessary to recognize the hazard and take appropriate actions when responding to an incident involving hazardous materials in a transportation incident. Upon completion of this unit, the student should be able to identify the regulatory requirements that apply to first responders of hazardous materials incidents and the role of the first responder at the awareness level.

Course Objectives:

1. Define the different types of hazardous substances and identify the risks associated with them in an incident.
2. Given a simulated incident involving hazardous materials, identify the potential outcomes.
3. Given the data available during an incident response, demonstrate recognition of the presence of hazardous substances.
4. Given the data available during an incident response, identify hazardous substances present.
5. Define the role of the first responder awareness individual in the employer's emergency response plan including site security and control and the North American Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG).
6. Given a simulated incident, determine the need for additional resources, and make appropriate notifications to the communication center.
